## Double Carpenter Star

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King Size Quilt is 115 " X 115"

Supplies Needed:
2 Layercakes ( $\mathbf{1 0 " ~}^{\prime \prime}$ Square Packs)
$53 / 4$ Yard Background \& Border 1
2 Yards Border 2

Borders are optional
Quilt will be about $1021 / 2$ X $1021 ⁄ 2$ without borders.

## Addional Supplies:

Sticky Dots or Sticky Notes
Or Clips or Pins with a Numerical up to $\mathbf{7 2}$ system.

The Video on Tiffany's Quilting Life gives visual instructions to complete this quilt.
As said in the video, this can essentially be made with whatever size squares you want. These instructions are for the King Size Version.

## Directions:

From Background
Step 1- Cut 9 Strips at 10 " by WOF
Step 2-Sub Cut 10" Squares for a total of 36 Squares
Step 3- Sub Cut those 10" once on the diagonal


Step 4- Cut 9 Strips at 9" by WOF
Step 5-Sub Cut to 9" Squares for a total of 32

## Layercakes:

Pull out 72 Squares that you want to use for your quilt. Once you have chosen, then take the time to mark 2 tabs per block on the sides as shown in Video. Once you have marked the way you would like then cut all your squares in half one time.


Now to start pairing. Use the Video as guidance. The chart below is a list of the order of all the combos. There is also a diagram to reference on page 5. Letter $B$ stands for Background.

Now piece the pairs with a quarter inch seam. Press the seams open.

Directions for assembly are simple. Unlike most quilts, we will assemble quarters first. So, this is $\mathbf{1 2}$ across by 12 down. Split that into 4 sections of 6 . Draw a line down the center horizontally of the drawing below. Then draw a line across vertically. That will give you your sections to lay out.

Follow the video directions if you need further help.
Piece the sections in 6 rows of 6 according to your chart below. Press all seams open to help this quilt lay as flat as possible.

Once you have made 4 quadrants' then you would assemble like a giant 4 patch. Again, pressing the seams open.

If you are doing borders. Cut 11-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips off your remaining background yardage. Piece them together end to end and sew the sides on to the quilt. Then sew the top and bottom.

With your border yardage, cut 11-5" strips. Sew together end to end and sew on like border 1. Or you can miter the borders like I show in the video. That is completely up to you how you sew your borders on. I just am guiding you as far as the quilt top.

## SIDE NOTES:

This quilt layout is designed so you can use a rainbow of color. It helps the repeat fabrics of a layercake be more spread out throughout the quilt. You should try the Rainbow Color Version as I show in my Video. This can be made in any size. So, if you want to use 2 Charm Packs or some scraps, the sky is the limit. Just remember that the size of your HST needs to be the same size you cut your background solid squares. So, if your HST is 9.5" unfinished then you need 9.5" Solid Squares.
